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Agastache, Korean Anise Hyssop: (P) 1-2 feet. Sweet anise flavor. Purple flower spikes in summer, leaves and flowers are edible.

Angelica: (B) 5-8 feet. Beautiful green Flower heads on tall hollow stocks . Summer blooming.

Basil, African Blue: (A) 2-3 feet. Highly scented purple/green leaves with purple flowers. Good cut flower.

Basil, Greek Columnar: (A) 3 feet tall Very upright grower. Good basil scent.

Basil, Osmin Purple: (A) 2 feet tall. Darkest purple leaved basil.

Basil, Lemon 'Mrs. Burns': 2 feet. Small green leaves with white flowers. Strong lemon scent and flavor.

Basil, Spicy Globe: (A) 1 foot. Tiny green leaves. The best for growing Indoors. Great basil flavor.

Basil, Sweet 'Genovese': (A) 2 feet. Best basil for culinary use. Great in pesto.

Basil, Thai: (A) 2 feet. Spicy flavor, green leaves, purple stems.

Burnet, Salad: (P) 1 foot. Deeply cut Edges on blue-green leaves. Cucumber/walnut flavored leaves .

Catmint: (P) 1-2 feet. 'Dropmore' variety. Gray-green foliage with bluish-purple flowers. Strongly aromatic. Cats don't like this plant.

Catnip: (P) 1-2 feet. Heart shaped leaves. White flower spikes. This is the one cats love. Home tested.

Catnip, Lemon: (P) 1-2 feet same as above, but with lemon flavor and scent. Still a favorite with cats.

Chamomile, German: (A) 3-5 inches. Low growing lacy foliage. Small daisy like flowers sweetly scented. Flower heads used for tea.

Chamomile, Roman: (P) 6 inches. Ever-green perennial with feathery leaves. White daisy-like flower used in herbal tea.

Chives: (P) 12-15 inches. Clump forming Long grass-like hollow leaves. Small round lavender flowers. Leaves and flowers are edible. Mild onion flavor.

Chives, Garlic: (P) Same as above, but with a slight garlic flavor and thinner flat leaves with white flowers. Seeds.

Chives, Corkscrew: (P) Same as above, but with a slight garlic flavor and thicker flat leaves with purple flowers.

Coriander, Vietnamese: (TP) 1-2 feet. Part shade. Flavor similar to cilantro. Does not bolt like cilantro.

Curry Plant: (TP) 18 inches. Silver leaves, yellow flowers mild curry scent. Flavor doesn't carry over to cooking. Good dried flower.

Cutting Celery: (A) 18 inches. Dark green foliage resembles regular celery. Leaves used, both fresh and dry.

Dill, Bouquet: (A) 28-30 inches. Compact plant. Dill seed used in pickles, vinegars. Leaves for salads etc.

Dill, Fernleaf: (A) 25-28 inches. Dwarf Plant with abundant seeds.

Fennel, Bronze: (P) 3-5 feet. Same as green fennel but with dark reddish-Bronze foliage.

Feverfew, Double White: (TP) 1-2 feet. Bushy plant with light green leaves and small double, daisy-like white flowers.

Feverfew, Golden: (P) 1-2 feet. Bushy plant with bright yellow leaves and small daisy-like white flowers.

Lavender, Dentata: (TP) 2 feet. Serrated light green fragrant leaves topped by lavender flower spikes.

Lavender, 'Hidcote':(P) 12-18 inches. Silver gray foliage with deep blue flowers.

Lavender 'Munstead': (P) 12-18 inches. Gray green leaves with lavender flowers.

Lavender 'Provence': (P) 2-2 1/2 feet. Long bloom spikes of light purple. Hardier than most lavenders for us.

Lavender Fernleaf: (TP) Soft, lacy, deep cut blue-green foliage. Heavy flowering.

Lavender 'Goodwin Creek': (TP) Attractive silvery toothed plant with long deep purple flowers. Great in containers. Not hardy.

Lemon Balm: (P) 3 feet. Will grow in part shade. Lemon scented oval toothed medium green leaves. Good for tea. Spreads!

Marjoram, Sweet: (TP) 1-2 feet. Savory sweet flavor. Used in soups and stews. Pink and white flowers.

Mint, Apple: (P) 2-3 feet. Apple scented large bright green leaves.

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Mint, Chocolate: (P) 1-2 feet. Fragrance and taste of a peppermint patty.

Mint, Grapefruit: (P) 1 foot. Mild spearmint/grapefruit flavor. Light green foliage.

Mint, Orange: (P) 6 inches. Bronze and green leaves. Nice orange-mint flavor.

Spearmint 'Kentucky Colonel': (P) 1-2 feet. Old fashioned mint. Famous for mint juleps.

Spearmint, Regular: (P) 1-2 feet. Old fashioned mint. Famous for mint juleps.

Mint 'Curly': (P) 1-2 feet. Old fashioned mint. Famous for mint juleps.

Mint, Peppermint : (P) 1 foot. Strong sharp mint flavor.

Mint, Pineapple Variegated : (P) 1 foot. Cream and green leaves, fine pineapple scent and flavor.

Oregano, Greek: (P) 1 foot. Strong grower, very pungent flavor.

Oregano, Hot and Spicy: (P) 1 foot. Greek type with even more zing.

Oregano, Italian: (P) 1-2 feet. Bright green leaves with loose upright habit. Sweet flavor, small flowers.

Oregano, Cuban: (P) 1-2 feet. Bright green leaves with loose upright habit. Sweet flavor, small flowers.

Parsley, Italian Flat: (B) 6-8 inches. Flat leaf. Best flavor for cooking.

Parsley, Moss Curled: (B) 6-8 inches. Curly leaf, best for garnish.

Pennyroyal: (TP) 6 inches. Ground cover. Great mint scent when crushed. Not edible.

Rosemary, Arp: (P) 1-3 feet. Hardier than most. Upright habit. gray leaves, light blue flowers.

Rosemary, Prostrata: (TP) 6-12 inches. Trailing habit small green leaves. Many blue flowers in winter. Also good container plant.

Rosemary, Salem: (P) 1-3 feet. Hardier than most. Upright habit, green leaves, blue flowers.

Rue: (P) 3 feet. Lacy blue-green leaves with yellow flowers from mid-summer into fall.

Sage, Berggarten: (P) 18 inches. Large silver gray oval leaves. Non-flowering, excellent culinary sage.

Sage, Clary: (B) 3 feet. Heart shaped gray leaves. Tall blue flowers in second year. Ornamental.

Sage, Dwarf: (P) 2 feet. Smaller leaves than regular garden sage, blue flowers. Strongly aromatic.

Sage, Garden: (P) 2 feet. Gray-green lance-like leaves, with blue flowers. Strongly aromatic.

Sage, Golden: (TP) 18 inches. Chartreuse leaves edged in gold. Mild flavor.

Sage, Mexican Bush: (TP) 4 feet. Purple flowers in fall. Very ornamental.

Sage, Pineapple: (TP) 2-4 feet. Light green leaves with red flowers in fall. Great pineapple scent. Good in cooking and for tea.

Sage, Purple: (P) 1-2 feet. Mild flavor, purple and green leaves with purple stems. Very beautiful in the garden.

Sage, Tricolor: (P) 1-2 feet. Mild flavor, not as hardy as purple sage, white, purple, and green leaves.

Santolina, Virens: (P) 1 foot. Deep green aromatic foliage. Bright yellow flowers in summer.

Savory, Winter: (P) 12 inches. Pungent flavor. Good culinary herb. Reminiscent of thyme. Good in soups, stews and sauces.

Tarragon, Texas: (TP) 3-4 feet. Anise-like flavor makes it a good substitute for tarragon as it thrives in our climate.

Thyme, Caraway: (P) 4 inches. Best ground cover thyme. Caraway scent and flavor.

Thyme, English: (P) 6-8 inches. Round very green leaves. Semi-creeping habit. Most popular of our thymes for cooking.

Thyme, Golden Lemon: (P) 6-12 inches. Upright form with yellow and green leaves. Great lemon scent and flavor.

Thyme, 'Morningside Gold' (P) 6-12 inches. Upright habit with very gold leaves with a small blue-green splash in the center. Pink stems. All our own.

Thyme, Oregano: (P) 12 inches. Round dark green leaves, oregano scent.

Thyme, Silver: (P) 4-6 inches. Upright habit. Silver gray leaves edged in white. Good flavor.

Thyme, German Winter: 9 inches. Very upright habit. Strong grower. One of our best culinary varieties.

Thyme, Mother of Thyme: 9 inches. Very upright habit. Strong grower. One of our best culinary varieties.

Thyme, Wedgewood: 12 inches tall. Variegated leaf, golden center with blue-green edge. Good culinary thyme.
