### **ACHILLEA** (yarrow)

'Fireland' Bright red fading to cream.

'Parkers Gold' Bright yellow' flat flower clusters. Very drought resistant.

'Summer Wine' Rich burgundy flowers age to blush zinfandel.

### **AJUGA** (bugleweed)

'Burgundy Glow' Pink & silver variegation with blue flowers. Good ground-cover.

'Silver Beauty' Silver & light green foliage with light blue flowers.

'Catlins Giant' Big' bold bronze-green foliage with 10-12inch dark blue flower spikes in Spring.

### **ALCHEMILLA** (Ladies mantle)

*mollis* Gray-green leaves, Yellow-green flowers.

### **ARABIS** (rock cress)

'Snowcap' White, early Spring bloomer. Good in rock gardens.

### **ARMERIA** (sea pinks)

'Splendens' Rose pink flowers with green grassy foliage.

### **ASTER**

'Woods Purple' 12in. tall. Deep purple flower Aug.-Oct.

### **ASTILBE**

*taquetii* 'Superba' Later blooming & somewhat more drought tolerant than other astilbes. To 3ft. Tall with rosy purple blooms.

### **CALAMINTHA** (calamint)

*nepeta* 12-15 in. airy flower plumes in mid-summer to fall. Mint scented foliage. Not invasive.

### **CAMPANULA** (bellflower)

*poscharskyana* Serbian bellflower. Spreading habit. Violet flowers.

*glomerata* 'Superba' Clustered bellflower. Deep violet blue flower clusters over mounding plant. Sun. 24in. tall.

*Persicifolia* 'Telham Beauty' To 3ft. Tall. Unusually large rich blue flowers.

*rotundifolia* Bluebells of Scotland.

Nodding 1in. bells on 12in. stems.

### **CHRYSANTHEMUM**

*Superbum* 'Alaska' (Shasta daisy) Bright white 4in. Single flowers. 30in. Tall.

Summer bloomer.

*nipponicum* (Nippon Daisy) White daisies over very leathery foliage. Fall blooming, but great foliage all season.

### **COREOPSIS** (tickseed)

'Early Sunrise' Double, gold flowers.

Long bloom time. 20in.

'Sunfire' New. Large single flower, yellow with burgundy center. 16in. Tall.

*Rosea* Pink flowers over thin fern-like foliage. Aggressive native plant. Dutch plant of the year for 1993.

### **DELOSPERMA** (iceplant)

*cooperii* Rose-pink flowers from summer through fall over succulent foliage. Needs good drainage.

### **DIANTHUS**

'Zing Rose' Bright rose-red flowers bloom all summer.

'Firewitch' Spreading, low-growing form with magenta blooms.

### **DIGITALIS** (foxglove)

*lutea* Perennial foxglove. Tiny, creamy yellow nodding flowers run up only one side of the stems. 2-3ft.tall. Perennial.

*mertonensis* True perennial foxglove.

Deep pink with contrasting crimson spots. P. 'Apricot' Unique apricot orange color.

4ft. tall. Biennial.

*purpurea* 'Snow Thimble' All white with no spots on flowers. 4ft tall. Biennial.

*purpurea* 'Giant Shirley' Delightful mix of colors with extra large flowers. Biennial

### **ECHINACEA** (cone flower)

*Purp. Magnus* Rose colored, reflexed petals & a gold cone.

P. *Ruby Star* More intense color. New variety.

*Purp. White Swan* Creamy white flowers & a gold cone.

### **FILIPENDULA** (meadowsweet)

*hexapetala* Fernlike foliage in a rosette. Creamy white flowers are borne in yarrow-like clusters. 2-3ft.tall. Part-shade.

### **GAILLARDIA** (blanket flower)

'Burgundy' Tall glowing' wine-red flowers blooms mid to late summer. 30in. tall.

'Goblin' Yellow and red bi-color.

Compact. 12 inches.

### **GENTIANA** (gentian)

*Dahurica* 'Nikita' Intense blue upfacing whorls on many flowering stems. 16in.

Tall. Sun. Medium moisture.

### **GEUM**

'Mrs. Bradshaw' Orange-scarlet double flowers in Summer. Full sun.

### **GRASSES, ORNAMENTAL**

*Calamagrostis brachytricha*

(Korean feather reed grass) 3 ft. tall pink to white plumes in Sept. Does well in part-shade.

*Carex comans* 'Bronze'

(sedge) Bronze colored sedge makes a unique addition to the garden. Great in mixed containers. 8-12in. tall.

*Chasmanthium lat.* (northern sea oats)

To 4ft. tall. Good sun or shade grass. Self-seeds.

*Luzula nivea* (snowy woodrush) 1-2ft. tall part/shade to shade grass with wide hairy leaves. Works well in groups.

*Stipa tenuissima* (Mexican feather grass) 18in.tall. Beautiful, bright green hairlike foliage ages to cream late in season. Also called ponytail grass.

### **GYPSOPHILA** (Baby's Breath)

*repens* Dwarf creeping rock garden plant with tiny white flowers.

### **HEUCHERA** (coral bells)

'Palace Purple' Burgundy evergreen foliage & white flowers. Former Perennial Plant of the Year.

### **HIBISCUS**

*coccineus* Native. To 6ft. or more. Deep red flower 3in. across. Beautiful maple-like foliage.

### **HOLLYHOCK**

'Chater's Salmon' To 7 feet. Fluffy double red-orange blooms.

'Chater's Scarlet' Double scarlet blooms.

'Nigra' Dark maroon flowers. Called the black hollyhock.

'Chaters Golden Yellow' Double golden yellow flowers.

**KNIPHOFIA** (red hot poker)

'Pfitzers Variety' To 3ft. Tall. Stiff spikes of red, orange & yellow over leathery foliage. Full sun. Well drained soil.

**LAMIASTRUM**

g. 'Hermann's Pride' Small green and silver leaves. Mound forming.

**LIATRIS** (gayfeather)

spicata Lilac-rose flowers. 2-3ft. tall. Good cut flower.

**LOBELIA** (cardinal flower)

cardinalis Brilliant red flower spikes in late summer. Prefers partial shade. Moist soil.

gerardii vedrariensis Magnificent tall, striking royal purple flowers .

**LYCHNIS** (catchfly)

coronaria Rose Campion. Woolly 2-4in. Long leaves are grayish-green & contrast nicely to the rose-red flowers. 2ft. Tall. Sun to part-sun.

viscaria 'Fire' 2inch deep purple red flowers. Easy plant to grow.

**LYSMACHIA** (creeping jenny)

num. 'Aurea' Golden foliage groundcover..

**MALVA** (rose mallow)

alcea 'Fastigiata' 3-4ft. upright plant with small pink flowers most of the summer. Heat & drought tolerant.

**MONARDA** (bee balm)

'Jacob Cline' 5ft. upright plant with large red flowers June-Aug. Average to moist conditions.

'Raspberry Wine' 3-4ft. upright plant with clear wine-red flowers..

**NEPETA** (catmint)

mussinii 'Walkers Low' Named for english garden. Blue blooms from April to fall.

**OENOTHERA** (evening primrose)

Fruiticosa 'Youngii' Common sundrops. 18-24in.tall. Spreads vigorously. 1-2in. bright yellow flowers in early summer. Full sun & tolerant of dry soils once established

**PAPAVER** (poppy)

orientalis 'Allegro' Scarlet blooms with black eyes. 16 inches.

o. 'Brilliant' Orange-scarlet with black eye.

o. 'Royal Wedding' Pure white flowers with black centers.

o. 'Princess Victoria Louise' Salmon pink with black center.

**PENSTEMON** (beardtongue)

dig. 'Huskers Red' 2-3ft. tall. White bell flowers over bronze-purple foliage.

**POLEMONIUM** (jacob's ladder)

caeruleum Blue Attractive fern-like foliage with light blue flowers in spring. Part shade.

caeruleum White Attractive fern-like foliage with white flowers in spring. Part shade.

**RATIBIDA** (Mexican hat)

columnifera Droopy red flowers with pointed cone in center. Prairie native. Sun.

pinnata Golden yellow flowers with black centers. Blooms July-Sept. 2-3 feet.

**RUBBECKIA** (blackeyed susan)

'Goldsturm' Golden yellow flowers with black centers. Blooms July-Sept. 2-3 feet. maxima Big, bold, blue leaves with light yellow flowers & very large brown cones. 6-8ft. tall.

**RUMEX** (bloody sorrel)

sanguineus Vivacious foliage plant, large dark green leaves with red veins. Drought tolerant once established.

**SAPONARIA** (soapwort)

ocymoides Great rock garden plant with pink flowers in spring.

**SAGINA** (Irish Moss)

subulata Tight mat-forming, moss-like plant with tiny white flowers. Great for stone walkways.

**SCABIOSA** (pincushion flower)

ochroleuca Creamy yellow flowers. Full sun. Self-sows.

**SEDUM** (stonecrop)

dasyphyllum Tiny blue foliage resembles bunches of grapes. White flowers in Spring. Good trough plant.

'Fuldaglut' Red foliage. Red flowers in July. Good groundcover.

'John Creech' 2in. tall. Spreading sedum with pink blooms. Good groundcover.

kamtschaticum Scalloped green leaves with yellow flowers.

lineare 'Variegatum' Narrow succulent pale green leaves with creamy variegation.

sexangulare Dense carpets of fine green foliage. Ground cover.

ternatum Native. White flowers in Spring. Works well in part-shade.

tetractinum Spreading sedum with yellow flowers.& bright green foliage. Sun to part-shade.

s. 'Tricolor' Green & white with splashes of red. 3-4in high.

'Weinstephaner Gold' Low groundcover with gold flowers in June. Red seedheads.

**SEMPERVIVUM** (hens and chicks)

'Silverine' Medium green with reddish cast.

**SISYRINCHIUM** (blue-eyed grass)

angustifolium Bright blue star shaped flowers over fine iris-like foliage all Spring.

**STACHYS**

byzantina (lamb's ears) Silver, woolly white foliage. Lavender flowers.

**TEUCRIUM** (germander)

hyrcanicum Fuzzy lambs ear-like foliage & deep purple flower spikes. Sun. Very different than other germanders.

**THALICTRUM**

aquilegifolium Charming, large well branched pink panicles in lilac shades.

**VERBENA**

'Homestead Purple' Bright purple flowers. Blooms June-Sept. Hardy with protection and good drainage. 6-10 inches.

**VIOLA**

labradorica Bronzy foliage with small blue flowers.
